

4 HOLIDAY DANGERS FOR DOGS

Tinsel and ribbon

Eating tinsel or other string-like items such as ribbon (often called linear foreign bodies) can cause serious damage to the intestine.



Chocolate

which can be toxic or even fatal to dogs. The toxicity depends on the amount and type of chocolate ingested. Signs can appear within 1 to 4 hours.



Mistletoe, poinsettias or holly

Mistletoe can be toxic to dogs. Poinsettias and holly can be very irritating if ingested. They all have the potential to cause irritation of the skin and/or mucous membranes and can cause excessive salivation and vomiting



Antifreeze

Dogs and cats find antifreeze quite tasty but even very small amounts can be fatal.
